CONSTRUCTION SITE ISSUED WITH A STOP-WORK ORDER OVER IMMINENT RISKS ON WORK AT HEIGHT

The Safety, Health and Environment National Authority (SHENA) recently issued a **Stop-Work Order** to a construction site due to imminent risks identified on work at height activities.

In response, the occupier of the affected premises has shown excellent cooperation in addressing the safety concerns by ensuring safer working at height practices. After significant improvements where there are no further imminent risks observed in connection to work at height activities, SHENA allowed for the **lifting of the Stop-Work Order**.

A reminder to all Occupiers, Employers, Principals, Employees and Self-Employed persons must at all times comply with the Workplace Safety and Health Act, Chapter 277 and the regulations made thereunder, and that every persons in the workplace has a personal and shared responsibility to create and maintain a safe working environment.
