Purpose: This Radiation Technical Note (RTN) serves to update stakeholders who have dealings and engagements with radiation matters under the Safety, Health and Environment National Authority (SHENA).

Authorisation by SHENA is required to import and export radioactive material and/or controlled apparatus in Brunei Darussalam as required under the Radiation Protection Act, Chapter 228.

This RTN is to inform that the list of Harmonised System (HS) Code under the Other Government Agencies (OGA-RAD) for radioactive materials and controlled apparatus under the purview of SHENA through the Brunei Darussalam National Single Window (BDNSW) website has been updated as follows:

NO	HS CODE	DESCRIPTION
1	26.12	Uranium or thorium ores and concentrates.
2	26.13	Molybdenum ores and concentrates.
3	26.14	Titanium ores and concentrates.
4	26.15	Niobium, tantalum, vanadium or zirconium ores and concentrates.
5	28.44	Radioactive chemical elements and radioactive isotopes (including the fissile or fertile chemical elements and isotopes) and their compounds; mixtures and residues containing these products.
6	84.01	Nuclear reactors; fuel elements (cartridges), nonirradiated, for nuclear reactors; machinery and apparatus for isotopic separation.
7	90.22	Apparatus based on the use of X-rays or of alpha, beta, gamma or other ionising radiations, whether or not for medical, surgical, dental or veterinary uses, including radiography or radiotherapy apparatus, Xray tubes and other X-ray generators, high tension generators, control panels and desks, screens, examination or treatment tables, chairs and the like.
