**Purpose:** This Note to Industry (NTI) serves as a notice to inform all principals, occupiers, employers, self-employed persons, and individuals of its new Regulations.

All stakeholders are hereby informed that the **Workplace Safety and Health (Work at Heights) Regulations, 2025** has been officially gazetted and is effective from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2025.

The **Workplace Safety and Health (Work at Heights) Regulations, 2025** contain provisions detailing the minimum workplace safety and health requirements that need to be adhered pertaining to the provision of activities involving work at heights at any workplace in Brunei Darussalam, including but not limited to ensuring all principals, employers and occupiers to take sufficient measures in ensuring all work at height activities are carefully planned, regulated and implemented correctly and safely by competent persons including the correct and suitable equipment to be used for work at height.

SHENA therefore seeks the cooperation of all stakeholders to ensure compliance with the regulations at your workplace. SHENA will also begin implementing and enforcing the law regarding this regulation.
