Purpose: This Note to Industry (NTI) serves as a notice to inform all principals, occupiers, employers, self-employed persons and individuals on its new Regulations.

All stakeholders are hereby informed that the **Workplace Safety and Health (Workplace Safety and Health Officers) (Amendment) Regulations, 2025** has been officially gazetted, and is effective from 1st January 2025.

The Workplace Safety and Health (Workplace Safety and Health Officers) (Amendment) Regulations, 2025 contain amendments to Schedule 2 of the Workplace Safety and Health (Workplace Safety and Health Officers) Regulations, which additionally requires the appointment of Workplace Safety and Health Officers at the following premises:

- Premises used for processing any hazardous substance, including exploration, exploitation, extraction, drilling intervention, handling, storage or disposal of the hazardous substances as well as premises used for the provision of offshore accommodation for persons working on another premises and services and maintenance of such premises; and
- Premises used in the operations, maintenance and provision of any public utility.

SHENA therefore seeks the cooperation of all stakeholders to ensure compliance with the regulations at your workplace. SHENA will also begin implementing and enforcing the law regarding this regulation.
