# WORKPLACE SAFETY AND HEALTH (WORKPLACE SAFETY AND HEALTH COMMITTEES) REGULATIONS



These Regulations shall apply in relation to every workplace in which 50 or more persons are ordinarily at work

## **WSH COMMITEE**

Meeting at least once a month

WSH Officer / Co-ordinator / Focal Point


ROLES AND RESPOSIBILITES	FUNCTIONS
Conduct WSH Meeting - at least once a month	General inspection of the workplace
Minutes of Meeting need to be captured	Inspection of workplace after accident or dangerous occurence
WSH Officer/Co-ordinator/ Focal acts as a secretary	Promote safety and health at the workplace

## WORKPLACE SAFETY AND HEALTH (RISK MANAGEMENT) REGULATIONS

In every workplace, the employer, self-employed person and principal shall conduct a risk assessment in relation to the safety and health risks posed to any person at work

- Any foreseeable risk shall be eliminated as far as reasonably practicable.
- Heirarchy of Control shall become a reference as a practicable measure to minimize the risk.

## **Hierarchy of Control**





 Record of risk assessment should be maintained for a period not less than 3 years and any measure of safe work implemented.

## WORKPLACE SAFETY AND HEALTH (INCIDENT REPORTING) REGULATIONS



Types of Reportable Incidents at a Workplace



WHO TO REPORT?	WHEN TO REPORT?
EMPLOYER	Death of employee Employee granted more than 3 consecutive days of sick leave Employee admitted in a hospital for at least 24 hours for observation and treatment
	Dangerous Occurance (i.e. fire, gas explosion, scaffold collapses, lifting equipment failure, etc.)
OCCUPIER	Death of any persons who is not at work and Self-employed person Any person or Self-employed person injured and taken to the hospital for treatment
MEDICAL PRACTITIONER	After diagnosis of any employee with an occupational disease
